PROFESSIONAL CLINICIAN (LEVEL 3)

Must complete Level 1 and 2 Plus:

- 2-Day Botany for Herbalists (on-site)
- One Herbal Monograph
- Wilderness First Aid Certification (16-hour)
- Botanical Functional Medicine 1 (Andrenal/Thyroid/Pancreas)

 - The Cardiovascular System
 - The Nervous System
 - The Musculoskeletal System
- Clinical Case Studies 2
- Onsite Clinical Rotations (40 hours minimum)
- 80% or higher score on Professional Clinician Exam

EXPERT CLINICIAN (LEVEL 4)

Pre-Requisites: Completion of Levels 1, 2 and 3 Plus:

- Botanical Functional Medicine 2
 - Clinical Case Studies 3
 - Onsite Clinical Rotations (80 hours minimum)
 - Serve as Clinical Co-Director of at least one clinical week
 - 1 Approved Herbal Monograph
- 80% or higher score on Expert Clinician Exam

CLINICAL HOURS

Up to 300 additional clinical hours can be completed through the following programs:

- 1) Onsite clinical internships in our integrative clinic (available starting summer 2023)
- 2) Teleclinic hours (available starting summer 2023)
- 3) Clinical weeks (free herbal care for underserved communities offered at least once per year)
